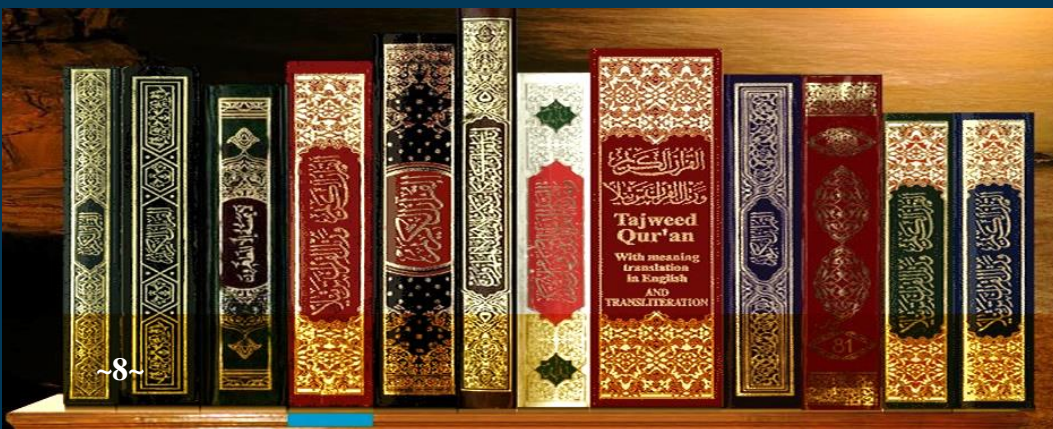


2.2 Why ALIM?
